Job Description – Fosterers

Rôle

- Providing temporary accommodation to stray, abandoned or injured cats and kittens in a Trust owned, purpose-built pen in your garden or in a suitably adapted room in your home
- Keeping the environment and equipment clean and in good condition
- Feeding, grooming and socialising cats and kittens care and treating them, as appropriate, for fleas, worms and other parasites
- Meeting the needs of every cat or kitten in your care which occasionally can be time consuming

- Experience of cats and kittens as personal pets and of their needs
- Good observational skills
- Good communication skills
- Ability to deal with potentially sensitive situations
- Ability to keep accurate records of the cats and kittens in care
- Commitment to finding new homes for the cats and kittens in care appropriate for their needs
